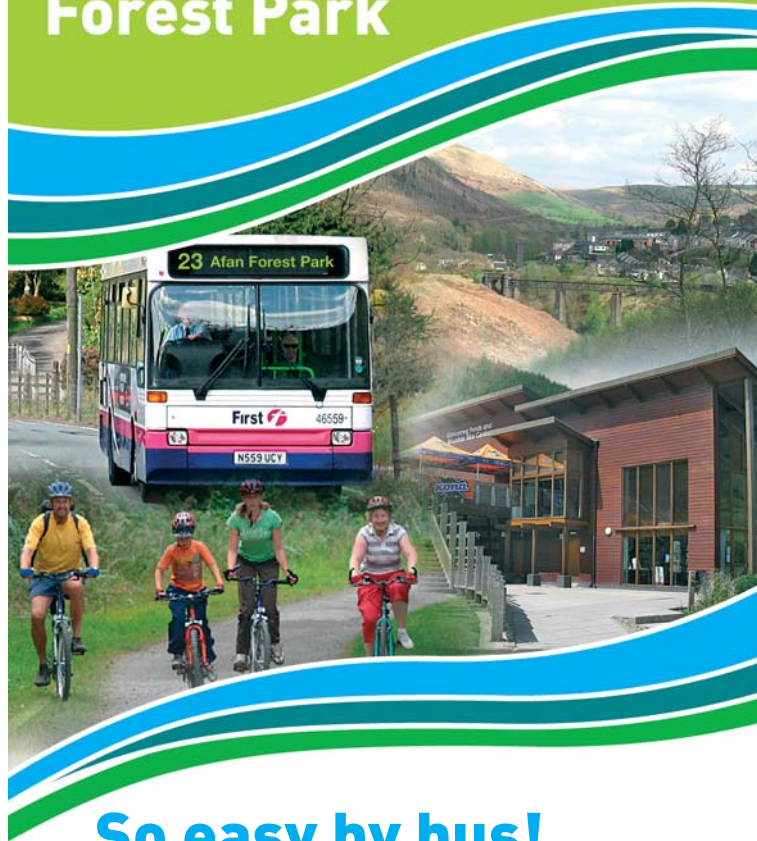

- 1.5m/2.5km easy/moderate
- Time:** 1 hour
- Start:** Cwmafan Community Centre
- Finish:** Pontrhydyfen Oakwood bus stop
